

NOTICE OF GROUND INVESTIGATIONS SURVEYS



As we develop the design of the HS2 high speed railway, we are undertaking ground investigation surveys near you. These surveys help us to understand the ground conditions near the planned route of the railway, so that any future construction is safe and efficient.

Beginning this week our contractor will been drilling on private land parallel to Diddington Lane, this is currently scheduled to continue into October 2016.

When this work is complete, our contractor will restore the area to its previous condition. Please note that these works are in advance of Royal Assent.

DURATION OF WORK

- Weekday working hours: between 8am and 6pm (excluding bank holidays).
- Saturday working hours: between 8am and 1pm.
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Background noise from the drilling of boreholes or digging of trial pits and the use of water pumps.
- Hoardings around ground investigation sites.
- Contractor vehicle movements to and from the sites.

WHAT WE WILL DO

- Inform you in advance of any changes to the dates shown.
- Keep all sites safe and secure.
- Ensure that contractor vehicles use agreed routes.
- Ensure that all sites are reinstated to the required standard.
