

Notice of updated southbound road and lane closures on the A452 and A446

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and Murphy & Sons known as LM. In your area, we are working near the A452, A45 and M42, which surround the site of the future HS2 Interchange Station.

We're creating a new access road

We need to create a new access road located off the A446 southbound to service a future construction compound. This road will tie into the existing road network and connect to haul roads on HS2 land, for the exclusive use of our construction vehicles. This new route, as well as those completed off the A452 and B4438, will reduce traffic disruption in the future and help to alleviate congestion. We need to carry out a number of road and single lane closures to protect our workforce, and the travelling public, whilst we carry out our works.

We'll be starting work on 10 November

To carry out our works safely, we will need to undertake traffic measures on the A452 and A446 southbound, between Sunday 10 November and Friday 20 December. This will include:

- Overnight road closures (see map on page 2)
- 24/7 single lane closures (see map on page 2)
- Daytime and overnight single lane and road closures (see map on page 3)

Signed diversion routes will be in place for the road closures. There will be designated road and lane closure times, but our contractors may be on site up to an hour before and after those times to set up and close down the site. Vehicle and pedestrian access to businesses, including Melbicks Garden Centre, will be maintained throughout our works.

Duration of work

From Sunday 10 November to Friday 20 December.

Daytime working hours will be 9.30am to 3.30pm, and overnight working hours will be 8pm to 6am.

What to expect

Daytime and overnight single lane and road closures at varying times of work.

24/7 lane closures until Sunday 15 December.

What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Ensure clear diversion signage is in place.

Leave the area in a tidy state when works are complete.

Maintain building access.



We have planned overnight road closures


We will be carrying out overnight road closures on the following dates from 8pm to 6am:

- A446 southbound: 10 November to 11 November (one overnight closure)
- A446 southbound: 15 December to 16 December (one overnight closure)



We have planned 24/7 single lane closures

We will be carrying out 24/7 single lane closures on the A446 southbound from 11 November to 15 December (24 hours a day, every day of the week).

We have planned daytime and overnight single lane and road closures

We will be carrying out overnight single lane and road closures on the following roads from 8pm to 6am:


- A446 southbound: 16 December to 20 December (overnight single lane closures)
- A452 southbound: 16 December to 20 December (overnight road closures)

We will be carrying out daytime single lane closures on the following dates, from 9.30am to 3.30pm, Monday to Friday:

A452 southbound: 11 November to 20 December (daytime single lane closures)

- = diversion route for overnight road closures
