PL/2025/01616/MINFHO | Resubmission of application PL/2024/02475/MINFHO. Two storey extension to the front and rear.

The Parish Council has one concern regarding the above application and that relates to the boxed feature behind the front red line site boundary line within the site itself. This feature/structure is not mentioned in this application and is not apparent as a current building/feature when viewing the site on Google Earth although we accept that might not be current.

We have three questions:

- 1) What is this feature?
- 2) If it's a built structure when was planning approval given for it? No reference to it appears to have been made in the original application PI2024/02475 although it appears on the layout plan.
- 3) Is it included in this application –if so why is there no mention of it in this application?
- 4) If it is not included in the application, any drawings/ diagrams showing it should be amended to show the site as it actually is.

We think it appropriate that this matter should be clarified prior to any further consideration being given to this application and would appreciate your comments.
