Diddington Lane full closure:

All day, every day from **9.30am on Monday 16 March 2026** until **9am on Saturday 19 September 2026**.

What we are doing

Traffic management will be installed on Diddington Lane to allow our workforce to safely complete essential utility diversions, and the new road alignment as part of our planned works.

The road will reopen to the public once these works are complete and it is safe to do so.

What to expect

Low level noise from our works.

A fully signed diversion route will be in place during each closure.

These works are subject to consent.

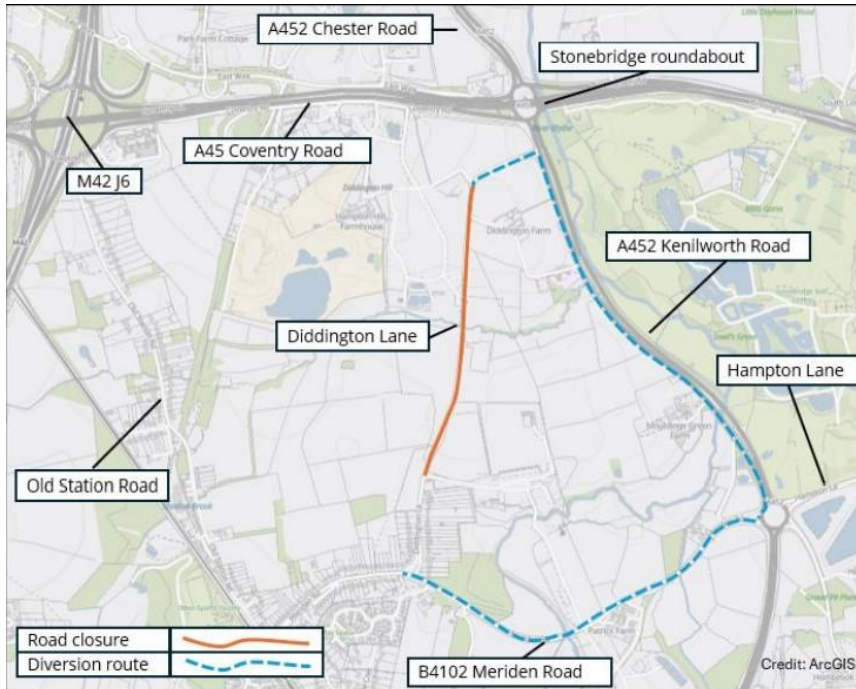

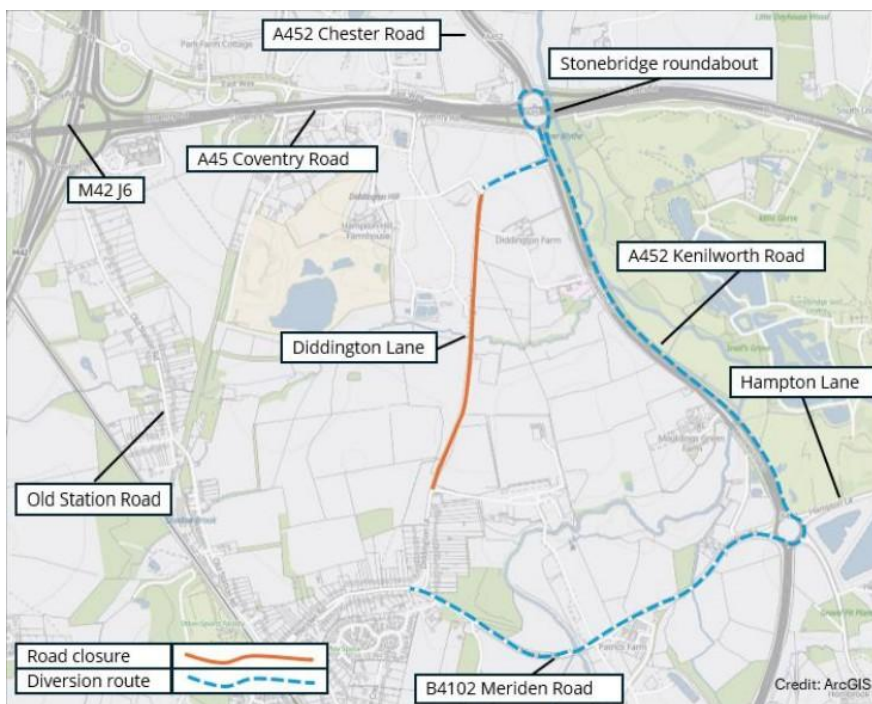
Diddington Lane northbound diversion route
